Notification

New Delhi, the _____ 2021.

G.S.R.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Agriculture, National Institute of Fisheries Post Harvest Technology and Training, Kochi (Processing Technologist), Group `B`, Recruitment Rules, 2009, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Processing Technologist in National Institute of Fisheries Post Harvest Technology and Training, Kochi under the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Fisheries, namely:-

(1) **Short title and commencement:-** (1) These rules may be called the National Institute of Fisheries Post Harvest Technology and Training, Kochi, (Processing Technologist (Group `B`) Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of post, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale:** - The number of said post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualification, etc.:** - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. **Disqualifications:** - No Person,-

(i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or

(ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other ground for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax:** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reason to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving:** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Schedules Tribes, Ex-Serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion: Processing – cum – Quality Assurance Supervisor in level 6 in the pay matrix (Rs.35,400-1,12,400) with six years' regular service in the grade.
Note : where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered for promotion provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.
Deputation: Officers under the Central Govt. or State Govt. or Union territories :
(a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department : or
(ii) with six years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Level 6 of pay matrix (Rs.35,400-1,12,400) or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department : and
(b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience :

Essential:

(i) M.Sc. degree in Food Technology or Chemistry or Fishery Science or Industrial Fisheries of a recognized University or equivalent.

Or

Two years' Diploma in Fishery Science from Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai.

(ii) Two years' practical experience in fish processing factories or two years' research experience in the field of fish processing

Desirable : Diploma in Marketing or Business Management

(The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.)

The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organizations / department of the Central Government shall not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
