**Subject: Addendum to the Guidelines of the CSS on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries.**

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No 27035-19/2015-Fy(IV) Vol-II dated 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 on the above subject through which the detailed implementation Guidelines, Cost Norms, Unit Costs and associated terms and conditions etc. in respect of all the components and sub-components of the CSS on "Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries" have been issued and the same has been uploaded in the Department's website (<http://www.dahd.nic.in>).


2. In continuation of the above, approval of the Competent Authority to the following addendum and rectification to the Guidelines of the CSS are hereby conveyed.

- (i) Adding a new provision for a medium size Re-circulatory Aquaculture System (RAS) with a unit cost of Rs. 50 lakh. Detailed guidelines in respect of this addendum are attached as Annexure-I to this letter.
- (ii) The capacity of large formulated pellet feed plant as at Item 7.2 of the Appendix-III of the Guidelines may be read as "***a minimum capacity of 10 tonne/day and more***", in lieu of the existing unit of 6 tonne/hr to 10 tonne/hrs. Rectified guidelines in respect of large formulated pellet feed plant is attached as Annexure-II of this letter. No changes have been made in the small size fish feed mills/plants.

3. The States/UTs may adopt the above said addendum and amendment suitable for formulation and implementation of the relevant fisheries projects/proposal.
