ORDER

The Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare has been implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme(CSS) on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries and provides central financial assistance to the State Governments/ Union Territories, Central and State Government Organizations and other stakeholders for development of fisheries. In order to examine, appraise and recommend feasible/viable proposals (except proposals relating to FHs & FLCs) for approval both from administrative and financial angles for central financial assistance under the CSS, the Department hereby constitutes a Central Approval and Monitoring Committee (CAMC). This is in continuation of the Revised Administrative Approval of even number dated 01st January, 2018, which require all proposals to be scrutinized by CAMC and sent to DADF, GoI for sanction.

The composition, ToRs and Terms and Conditions of the CAMC are indicated 2. hereunder.

2. Terms of Reference (ToR)

The CAMC shall examine, appraise and recommend feasible/viable proposals (except (a) proposals relating to FHs & FLCs) for approval of DADF both from administrative and financial angles as received after scrutiny by the NFDB.

- CAMC will hold its meetings at least once in a month on a regular basis to clear the (b) proposals recommended by the SLAMCs and NFDB for central assistance under the CSS. CAMC may also convene its meeting any time depending on the receipt of the proposals.
- CAMC will also review and monitor the projects approved under the CSS. The (c) monitoring meetings of CAMC shall be held on a quarterly basis to review the progress of the project taken up under the CSS.
- CAMC shall examine, appraise, and recommend the feasible/viable proposals for (d) approval and in accordance with the implementation guidelines, cost norms, unit costs, admissible funding pattern of the CSS and other advisories/guidelines/clarifications issued in respect of the CSS from time-to-time and also keeping in view the recommendation of SLAMCs.

3. Terms and conditions

- The expertise of Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR) Institutes will be (a) utilised appropriately as and when required.
- Joint Secretary (Fisheries), DADF being the chairman of the CAMC may co-opt any (b) member based on their expertise in the field as and when a need is felt to this effect.
- The committee, if need be, may consult States, UTs, Fisheries Institutes and the (c) fisheries stakeholders to solicit their views and inputs on the proposals as and when a need is felt to this effect.
- The concerned subject desks in the Fisheries Division, DADF shall provide the (d) requisite secretariat assistance to CAMC in examination of the proposals, preparation of the appraisal notes, proceedings, report etc.
- All the expenses required towards stationery, printing of requisite copies of the (e) proceedings, report of the CAMC, local travel, meeting costs etc., and also TA/DA of non-official members etc. shall be met under the CSS.
- (f) TA/DA of the official members will be met Departments/organisations. However, the TA/DA in respect of only non-official and by their co-opted members shall be met by the Fisheries Division under the CSS.
