



From among the following :-

1. Deputy Commissioner (Fishing Harbour);
2. Director, Central Institute of Fishing Nautical and Engineering Training;
3. Director, Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fisheries;
4. Director, National Institute of Fisheries Post Harvest Technology and Training,

With five years regular service in the scale of Level- 12 (78800- 209200) of pay matrix

The eligibility list for promotion shall be prepared with reference to the date of completion by the officers of the prescribed qualifying service in their respective grade or posts:-

Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation (Including Short Term Contract) :

Officers of the Central or State or UT Administration or Autonomous bodies or Recognised Research Institute or Universities or Statutory Bodies:-

- (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or
 - (ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment there to on regular basis in the scale of Level- 12 (78800- 209200) of pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:-

Essential:

- (i) Masters degree in Zoology with specialisation in Fisheries; or M.F.Sc. or M.Sc. in Marine Biology or M.Sc. in Industrial Fisheries or M.Sc. in Aquaculture or M.Sc. in Fisheries Science from a recognised University or Institute.
- (ii) Twelve years experience of research or development in the field of Fisheries (Inland or Marine or Aquaculture) including management, policy and planning, formulation and monitoring of development Schemes for fisheries, Parliament or legislative or international co-operation and trade or fishery health related matter from a Central or State Government Department or Public Sector Undertaking or Recognised Research Institute or Semi-Government or Statutory or Autonomous Organisation.

Desirable:

Doctorate degree in Zoology from a recognized University or Institute.

Note 1 : The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. The maximum age limits for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications).
