## Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month of November, 2023 in the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying

- 1 Hon'ble Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Shri Parshottam Rupala inaugurated the first Global Fisheries Conference India 2023 on World Fisheries Day 2023 at Science City, Ahmedabad, Gujarat on 21<sup>st</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2023. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat, Shri. Bhupendra Rajnikant Patel, Hon'ble Ministers of State, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Balyan and Dr. L. Murugan and other dignitaries also graced the occasion. ~14,000 participants attended the two-day event including 10 foreign missions, international organisations (FAO, World Bank, ADB, GIZ etc.) and Hon'ble State Fisheries Ministers from various States. The Conference also featured an exhibition showcasing new technologies and innovations int the fisheries sector in India. Approximately 200 exhibitors, including value chain processors, startups etc. participated in this exhibition. An International Roundtable was also organized to discuss areas of collaboration in R&D and new technologies. Besides experts and panel speakers were invited from ICAR, Fisheries Universities/Colleges and industry from India and abroad to participate in 10 technical and industry connect sessions on key focus areas such as co-operatives, deep sea fishing, inland fisheries, innovations, best practices and women empowerment etc.

Two fishing vessels of the Fishery Survey of India (FSI) sailed and conducted the exploratory survey programs for fisheries resources and marine mammal survey programme in and around the Indian Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) during the month. Senior Scientific Assistants of FSI attended the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission (IOTC) 19<sup>th</sup> Working Party on Data Collection and Statistics (WPDCS19) meeting held during 28<sup>th</sup> November to 02<sup>nd</sup>December, 2023 at Hotel St. Regis, Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- 18. Hon'ble Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Shri Parshottam Rupala chaired the Inter-Session Meeting of the Consultative Committee of the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India on the subject Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) and Marine Fisheries Development in Parliament House Annex (Extension Building), New Delhi on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2023. - 21. The Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery (CICEF) prepared and submitted techno-Economic Feasibility Report (TEFR) for the construction of Stage II Fishery Harbour at Tadadi in Uttara Kannada district of Karnataka.
- 22. The Central Institute of Fisheries Nautical and Engineering Training (CIFNET) conducted 21 fishermen outreach training programme for 200 fishermen.
- 23. The National Institute of Fisheries Post Harvest Technology and Training (NIFPHATT) conducted training programme on post-harvest management for 123 marine fisher women/ men comprising of 675 trainee days during the month.
- 24. The Grievance disposal under the CPGRAMS Portal for Department of Fisheries stood at 96 % as on 30<sup>th</sup>November, 2023.
